Ramadan Mubarak!

We would like to use this auspicious occasion to wish you all a blessed and a fulfilling month of Ramadan. May Allah SWT grant us all the *tawfeeq* to observe the fasting during the day and stand in prayers during the nights and do what pleases our Lord and Cherisher.

We can now confirm that the fasting will start on Monday, 6th of May 2019. Since we have opened the mosque only a few days ago and are still getting used to the site facilities, only water and dates will be provided to break the fast. Food and drinks are not permitted in the main prayer hall at any time. People, if they wish, may bring their own *iftar* packs and eat in the designated areas only. We encourage bringing of refillable bottles as there will be water dispensers for refilling - good for us and the planet.

The *Taraweeh* prayers will be held at 22:45 starting on Sunday, May the 5th. This particular timing for the *Tawareeh* prayers was selected for several good reasons. Firstly, it will enable us to keep the same timing throughout the month of Ramadan. Secondly, it will allow sufficient time for those worshipers who are coming from the city's surroundings and nearby towns to break their *iftar* at home without going through the stress and struggle of catching an imminent congregational prayer. It will also provide the local congregants with an option to attend an alternative *jama'at*, in the case one was late for an earlier congregational prayer offered elsewhere in Cambridge.

We would like to request our local brothers and sisters to walk to the mosque or cycle, if appropriate. If coming by car then please ensure that the entire family comes in one vehicle. Consider getting a lift from your neighbour whenever possible. Please park appropriately and do not disturb the neighbours when coming to and leaving the mosque site.

May Allah SWT bless you all, fulfil your wishes and bring peace and prosperity for all. *Amin*.
